The event day has various start times for all groups to line up in North Laines, the route is through the lanes and onto the seafront and finishes on Madeira Drive. The overall event starts at 9am and finishes at 1pm. At the end of March a detailed information pack regarding all aspects of the event will be sent out and I will keep you all updated.
