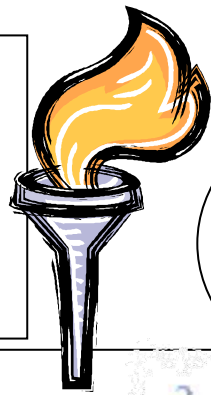

## History/Geography

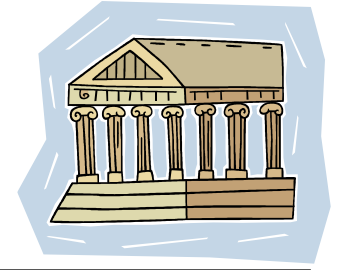
