

Uniform and PE Routines:

From September, children should attend school in their full uniform with school shoes, please. If they are scheduled to be undertaking PE (watch out for PINGS at the start of term) they are to attend in their School PE kit—this maximises the amount of time they can be in their Sports Lesson. Please do not send children to complete their sport in other sports clothing such as favourite football kits or kits from other sports clubs of which they may be part. If parents or carers do need help with uniform or sports kit for their children, please contact the school office in confidence—we can point you in the right direction and help!

School Days and Arrangements - Continued Dealing with Covid:

As expected, the arrangement of organising the school into 'bubbles' has been scrapped. Therefore, school will begin for everyone at 8.40am, with registration being completed by 8.50am. As now, members of the Senior Leadership Team will welcome children at the gate at the top of the path and children will walk across the carpark and into the building. Interventions and teaching will begin immediately after registration is closed, so punctuality is really important to ensure the planned work can be undertaken on time. Staff on duty will continue to provide hand sanitiser as children enter the school and we would appreciate it if we could continue with the wearing of masks during drop off and pick up.

At the end of the day, children in Years 1, 2,3,4,5 and 6 will leave from 3.10pm; Reception children will be released at 3.15pm. Parents and Carers are welcome to gather in the carpark to collect children; again, we'd welcome your support with the wearing of masks.

Details of Independent Learning and Remote Learning:

To support the children's learning in school, we will be publishing Independent Learning details for each year group via PING and our website in early September. It's unlikely that children will need to self-isolate unless they have had contact with someone with Covid, but we will still be providing remote work via the website and packs for children who need to work from home.

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
