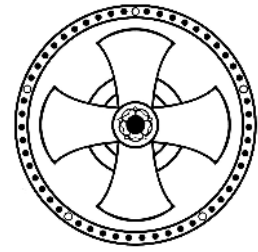

Please remember that we'll be delivering the donations on the 21<sup>st</sup> October, so everything need to be in by then, please. At the moment we're still in particular need of tinned goods and non-perishable food. Donations can be brought in and dropped off during in the morning between 8.40 and 8.50am.

Thanks too for those of you who have already replied to the PTFA about the Fireworks Evening and bought your tickets – it looks like being a really wonderful evening, so if you've not got your tickets yet (and there's still time) please do come and support us and have a great time into the bargain.

Earlier in the year when we all found ourselves locked down, we were approached by a parent who asked if we could support a charity that she was involved in. Unfortunately, we weren't able to do this in the Spring, but, on October 21<sup>st</sup> we're raising awareness and funds for World Down Syndrome Day, and a charity that supports this work in Tanzania. We're asked to wear odd socks on October 21<sup>st</sup> and, for those that can, contribute £1 to the charity. If you'd like to donate, children can bring their £1 into school and we'll collect it and pass it on.
