Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you're well. I thought I'd update you to tell you that thanks to the flexibility of staff; it's unlikely that we'll need to close to any year groups this week unless Covid cases increase. The manner with which all staff have responded to our current situation has been superb; changing hours and patterns of working at a moment's notice and rejigging wider family commitments. I am completely indebted to them for this kind of support. We won't however have a celebration assembly this week but these will return after half term all being well.

In order to keep you updated with the progress that your child is making in school, we're holding a Parents Evening on March 10th from 3.30pm. Like before, this will be held in the Hall and each parent will be able to book a 5 minute appointment to speak to your child(ren)'s teacher, who will be able to update you on their last formal assessments at Christmas and their current attainment. Garbarz, our SENCO, she'll be in touch about a separate arrangement regarding this.

Last, I'd really appreciate some support around the uniform for sport, please. As you know, we have a school uniform for the children's PE lessons and it's this that should be worn, rather than their football tops, casual clothes or sports kit from other teams they're involved in. Thanks very much for your understanding in this matter.
