Dear Parents and Carers,

As you'd expect, after the start of term last week, this week is filling up nicely and there are plenty of updates to share with you.

Curriculum Overviews:

First, attached to this letter you'll find the curriculum overviews for your child's class. Over the past two years, we've moved away from a topic based approach to one where phonics and reading take centre stage. Books and reading now drive our curriculum and if you've been into our foyer, you'll have seen a visual representation of this. Through this approach and in partnership with you, we look to develop a deep love of reading and a fluency and confidence which prepares everyone not just for the challenges of secondary education, but for a life rich in reading and everything this brings. The plans also show what's being covered in all the different subjects across the year allowing you a greater grasp of what your child is working on and towards. The plans link together, showing a progression from Reception to Year 6 and are also available on your child's class page of the website.

Homework details will follow from individual class teachers as these differ according to ages and we'll also be in touch to give you some further information about our teaching of phonics and reading so that you can support at home.

Parental Consultation:

You'll have a chance to speak to your child(rens) teacher(s) at our first Parental Consultation of the year on <u>Wednesday October 19th</u>. The idea of having this so close to the start of the year is so that you can better understand how they have settled into new routines and lessons. Please check your PINGS for further details about how to make an appointment.

Open Evening:

Our first Open Evening of the year for prospective Reception Parents for September 2023 will also be held on the 19th October.
