## Our Lady of Lourdes protocol for responding to racial



Child, parent, or member of staff has a racial incident or concern

### Use your voice:

- Speak to your class teacher or teaching assistant who will offer follow-up guidance and support.
- All members of staff who are approached will follow the standard safeguarding response to reporting of incidents.

Ask to speak with Mrs Kirkwood (Anti-Racist Education Lead), Miss Hamilton (KS1 Anti-Racist Education support lead) or Mrs Philbrook (Headteacher)

# Trauma-informed safeguarding response

**Regulation first** – make sure all involved are emotionally regulated.

Thank the child for sharing.

**Listen** and ask questions for clarity

**Repeat** back what we have understood

**Acknowledge** the negative feelings that will have arisen

Acknowledge the **trust** needed to share

#### Step 1:

- Fact finding
- Investigation without judgement
- Conversations with all involved

There is a clear acknowledgment that not all racist incidents are originated with mal-intent or conscious choice and will be dealt with in a supportive and educational manner.

### Step 2:

- Restorative justice approach to resolving the incident
- All those involved informed of conversations, outcomes and next steps (where applicable).
- Recorded on CPOMS (our safeguarding system).
