This week's Gospel Focus: In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear how Jesus was a wonderful friend to Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. When his friends were sad, Jesus didn't just stand by – he cried with them because he felt their heartbreak in his own heart. Just as Jesus brought Lazarus back to life and asked his friends to "unbind him," we can use our kindness to help "free" others from their worries.
