### **This week's Gospel Focus: The Good Shepherd**

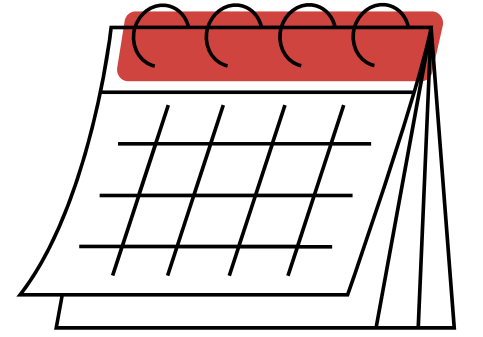
