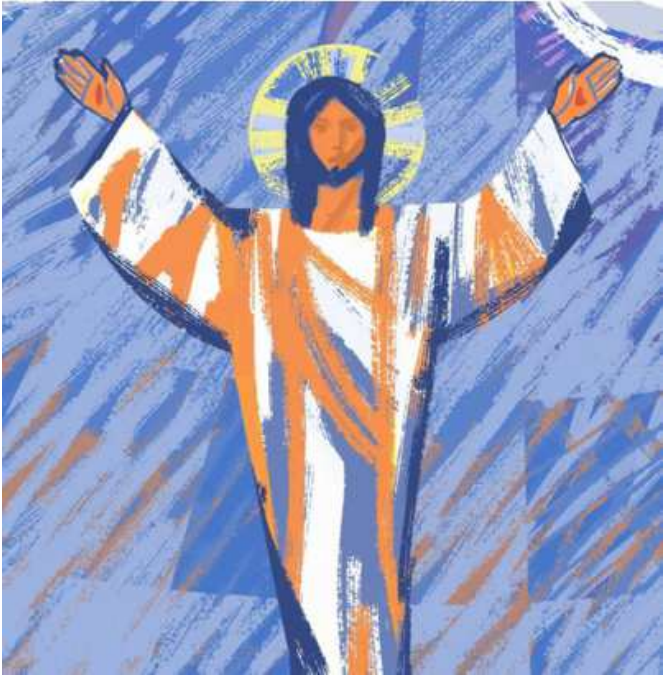

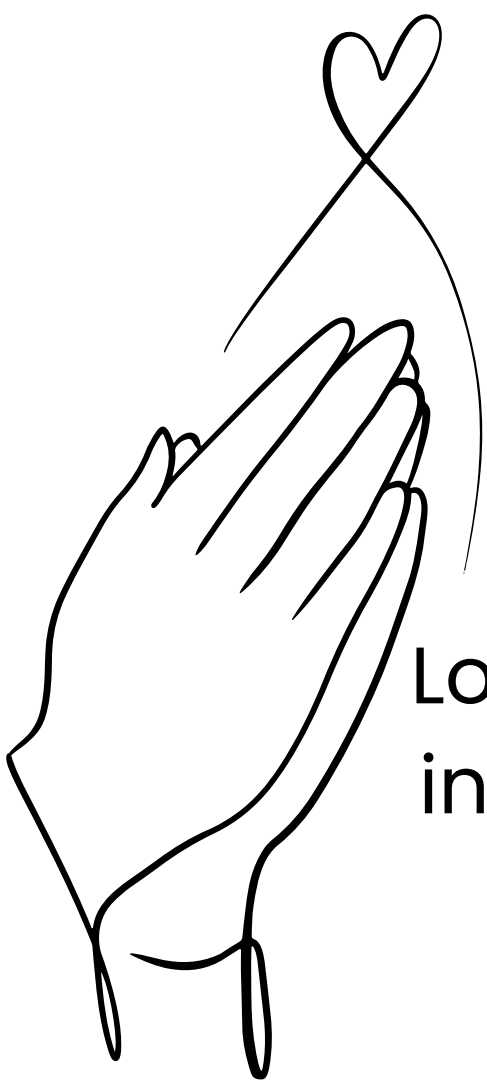
This week's Gospel

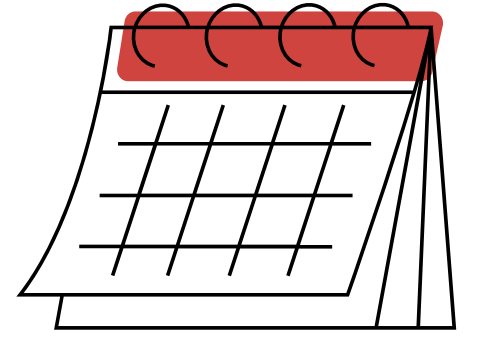
